Learning Objectives

Materials

- Garden BINGO
- Writing utensil
- End of day knowledge assessment

Overview

Students will search around the garden for the items listed on their BINGO card. The first person to get BINGO wins a prize!

Steps

- 1. Distribute a BINGO sheet to each participating student.
- 2. Release students into the garden in search of their BINGO items.
- 3. Collect all completed BINGO cards at the end of the game.
- 4. Have each student complete and hand in the "end of day" knowledge assessment before heading home!
