Learning Objectives

This lesson will enhance the mind, body and soul of participating students. As part of this lesson, students will:

- **Mind**
 - Identify vegetables and herbs growing in their school garden
 - Inventory the necessary supplies to sustain a garden
- **Body**
 - Exercise while in search of common garden items
- **Soul**
 - Connect with nature through spending time outside

Materials

- Garden BINGO
- Writing utensil
- End of day knowledge assessment

Overview

Students will search around the garden for the items listed on their BINGO card. The first person to get BINGO wins a prize!

Steps

1. Distribute a BINGO sheet to each participating student.
2. Release students into the garden in search of their BINGO items.
3. Collect all completed BINGO cards at the end of the game.
4. Have each student complete and hand in the “end of day” knowledge assessment before heading home!
